EXPLORING CAVES




Most caves are formed by water that soaks through the ground and drips on the rocks underneath. It takes thousands of years for this dripping water to carve out a cave.

Some of the world's best crystals and minerals are found in caves. The cave shown here is Lechuguilla (lech-oo-gee-ah) Cave near Carlsbad, New Mexico. The room shown here is called the Chandler Ball Room because of the large, beautiful gypsum crystals that hang down. The entrance to this cave was found in 1986, and it has 98 miles of maze passages!



Some caves have cool waterfalls, lakes and rivers. Cueva Juan Nieves in Puerto Rico, shown here, has the world's longest underground river (16.9 kilometers).






"Hydro Crystallation Station is the coolest creation"

"I love this set. There's so much stuff with it that you can play for hours," says William. "The flexible hose with the suction cup is really neat. I use the suction hose to pick up crystal boxes and move them into the Crystallation Station. You can also use the suction hose to catch and stop those sneaky Stingray ships as they swim past."

"The station is full of cool things. You pull a pin in the back, a trapdoor opens, and a Stingray falls into the dungeon. And by pulling a string in front, a door opens, and the stingray prisoner can escape. There's a landing pad in back for small ships, and the big expedition ship is one of my favorite things. It can explore, go on crystal finding missions, and protect the station. The three underwater animals are fun too!"
