

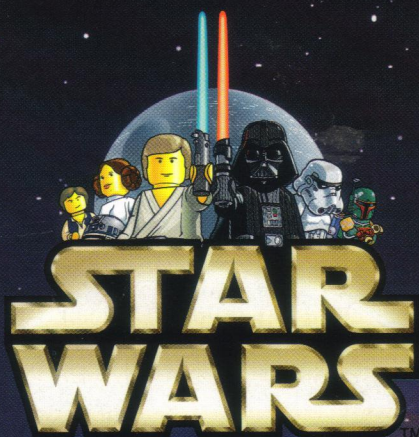

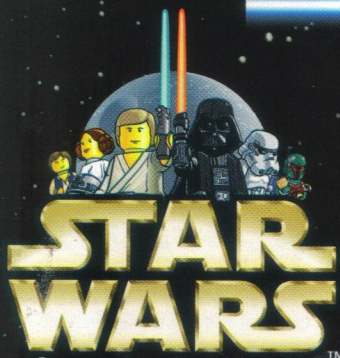

# THE BATTLE CONTINUES



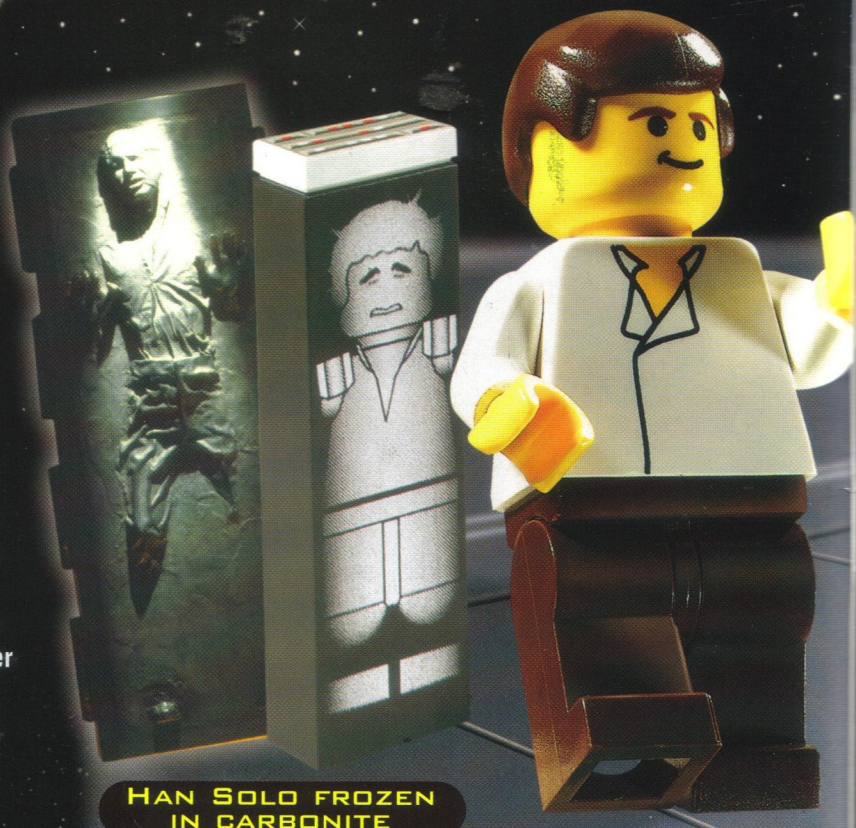

## BOBA FETT

Fett always has something dangerous up his sleeve — like a laser blaster, mini flamethrower, or grappling hook, and his BlasTech EE-3 rifle never leaves his hand. After Vader freezes Han in carbonite, Fett uses his ship, *Slave I*, to deliver Han to Jabba the Hutt.

## HAN SOLO

This crafty Corellian smuggler has escaped from many tough spots before, but in Bespin's Cloud City, Han's luck may have run out. Vader wants to freeze Luke Skywalker and take him to the Emperor. To test the carbon-freezing process on a human, Vader captures Han and freezes him first. Helplessly frozen in carbonite, Vader hands Han over to Boba Fett. The bounty hunter loads Han into the cargo compartment of *Slave I* and takes his frozen prisoner to Jabba the Hutt. In his desert palace on Tatooine, Jabba hangs Han on the wall like a picture!

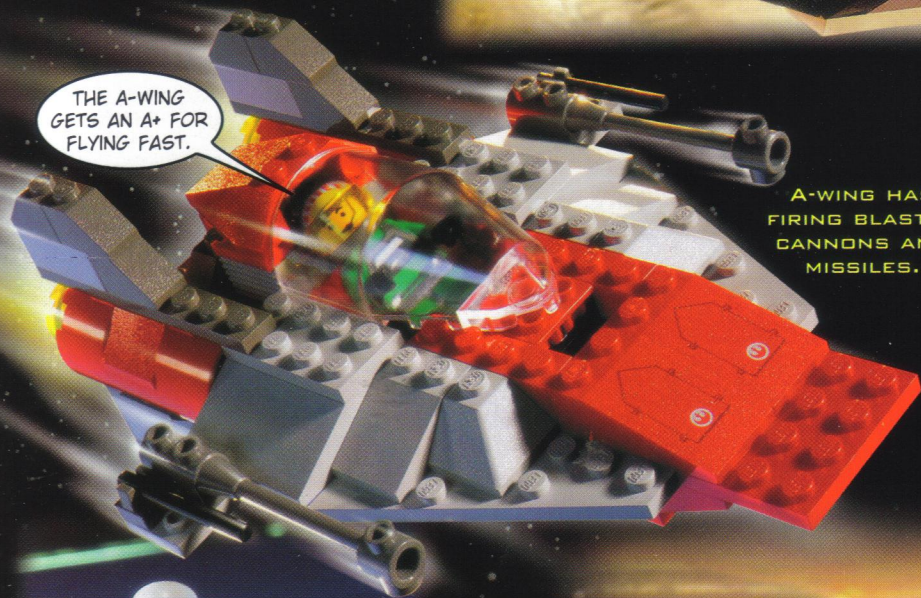


## 7104 DESERT SKIFF™

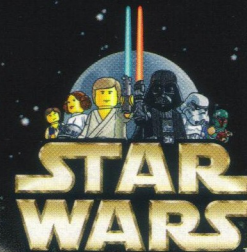

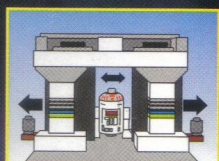

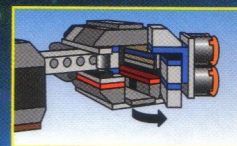

## 7180 B-WING™ FIGHTER

At the Battle of Endor, B-wing fighters helped with the assault on the second Death Star. One of the Rebels' most heavily-armed starfighters, the B-wing is also one of its most unusual ships. It is really one long, flat wing with a rotating cockpit at one end and ion cannon at the other. As a B-wing prepares for battle, two airfoils with cannons fold out of the wing. The B-wing has a special gyro-stabilization system. During a battle, the cockpit remains steady while the rest of the ship rotates around it. Besides its three ion cannons, the B-wing has a laser cannon, two proton torpedo launchers and two small blaster cannons.

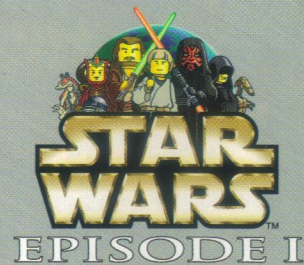

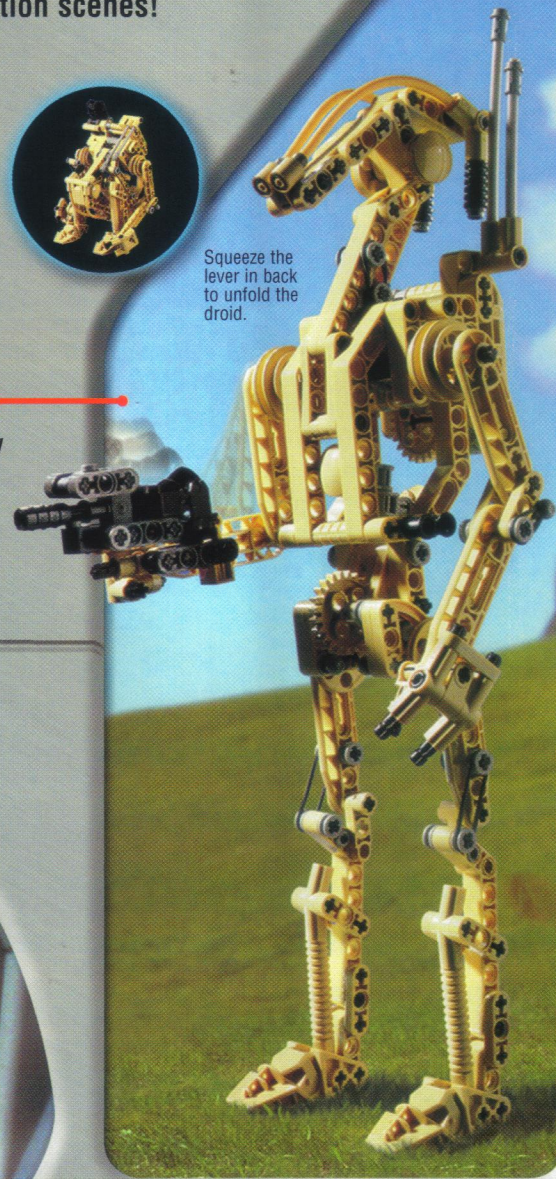


## 8000 PIT DROID™
