LEGO bricks start out their lives as little plastic granules in eight colors: blue, white, yellow, red, light gray, black, dark gray, and green. Then they are fed through pipes into molding machines, where they are melted, shaped, cooled and ejected. The new LEGO pieces are then taken to another factory, where the finishing touches are put on. Then they're ready to be packed into boxes for sale - and unpacked by you when you're ready to start building!

There are about 200 Master Builders at the LEGO company, designing and building everything from LEGO® DUPLO® models to LEGO® MINDSTORMS® robots to the giant sculptures at LEGOLAND®. 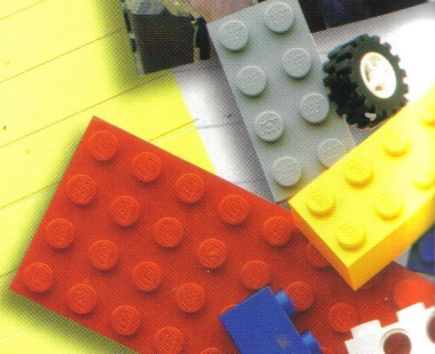
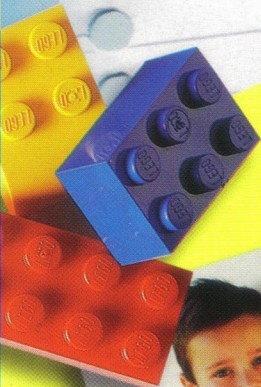
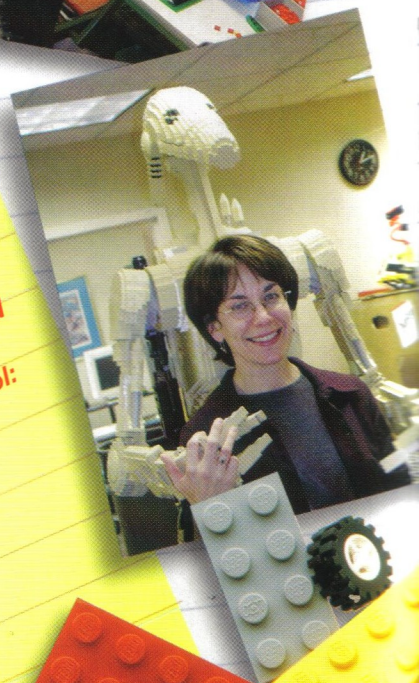

But what do we really know about these amazing "monsters of the deep?"

JUST SQUIDDING AROUND

If you wrote down a list of everything scientists know for certain about giant squid, it would be very, very short. **Giant squid live in the deepest parts of the ocean, sometimes as far down as 4,500 feet!** No one has ever captured a living giant squid, so important facts like what they eat, how long they live, even how big they can grow are still mysteries.

Giant squid are the world's largest invertebrates. An invertebrate (in-vur-tuh-brit) is a creature that has no backbone. An earthworm is an invertebrate but Giant Squid are much bigger! Giant squid have been reported to be anywhere from 55 to 65 feet long, and there may even be larger ones we have never seen.

Giant squid have tentacles, like an octopus, that they use to grab their prey. **They also have a beak like a parrot, which is strong enough to snap steel wire.** When they're threatened or afraid, they can shoot a cloud of black ink from a sac in their body to confuse their foes.

The only known enemy of a giant squid is a sperm whale, the largest species of whale in the ocean. We know that sperm whales like to eat giant squid, but nobody knows how they find them and catch them!

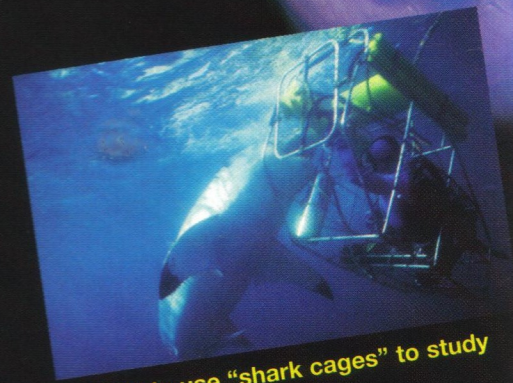
SNACK FOR A SHARK?

When you think of scary ocean creatures, you probably think of sharks. There have been lots of books and movies about sharks, and the news was full of stories about sharks attacking people last summer. How dangerous are sharks, and should you worry about one making a snack out of you?

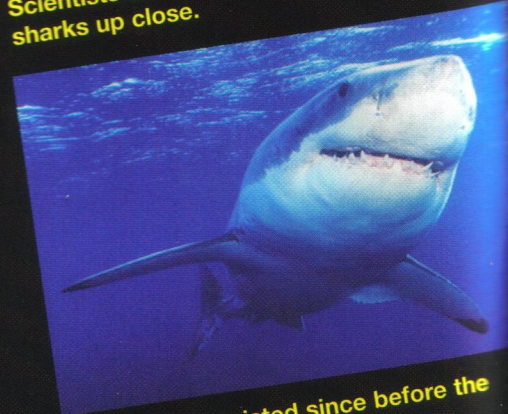
The truth is you have a better chance of being struck by lightning - twice! - than you do of being attacked by a shark. **Most shark attacks are actually the result of "mistaken identity."** In cloudy or murky water, the shark mistakes a swimmer or a surfer for a big fish or a seal.





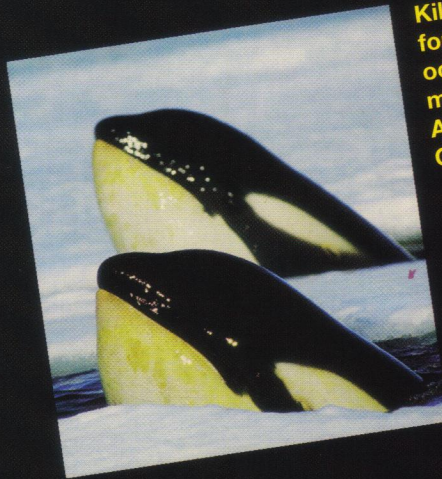
A giant whale shark. Notice the two divers swimming with him?

A WHALE WITH A BAD NAME

Killer whales have a pretty frightening name, but they're not as scary as they seem. No killer whale has ever attacked a person in the wild, in fact, they eat almost everything but people! **If a killer whale had a refrigerator**, it would be stocked with fish, squid, sharks, seals, whales, penguins, gulls, and octopi (and maybe peanut butter and jelly, too, who knows?)

Orcas grow to be about 30 feet long, which might seem small for a whale (some whales get as big as 60 feet long). **Killer whales are actually the largest member of the dolphin family!** If you had a killer whale for a pet, you could expect him to be around for a long time - male killer whales live to be about 60, and females live to be 90!

These are just a few of the "monsters of the deep" that live in the world's oceans. There might be more we don't know about yet - but if there are, you can be sure the Mission Deep Sea Squad will find them!



Killer whales can be found in many oceans, but they are most common in the Arctic and Antarctic Oceans.
